The HBB owner is required to comply with and is subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state or federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.  HBB's involved in food preparation and health services may need to be approved by Army Public Health and/or the Local Health Department. The applicant must provide documentation that states the HBB meets all applicable food & health safety and sanitation conditions. HBB food owner's must be aware of the time and temperature controls policies and Tri-Service Food Code. These documents are located on the MWR website.  The residential character of the property shall be maintained. The HBB may not occupy more than 25 percent of the home's gross floor area. Parts or materials related to the HBB shall be screened from public view and will be limited to the interior of the structure or the side and rear yards of the property. Signage is limited to what can be displayed in a single window from the inside and may not be illuminated.  Customers may only patronize a HBB between the hours of 0900 and 2130.  Noise, vibrations, or odors shall not be detectable beyond the property line.  General timeline to approve HBB application is 4 - 6 weeks, during w
